

STANDARDS OF ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Listed below are the <u>minimum</u> cumulative GPAs that must be achieved in order to remain in good academic standing. A GPA of at least a 2.0 is needed to graduate from the College. In some cases there is a requirement of a 2.5 or 3.0 GPA in order to enroll and complete a major discipline.

MINIMUM GRADE POINT AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS

Number of Hours Attempted	Minimum Required Cumulative GPA for Good Academic Standing
0-27 (First-Year Status)	1.6
28-59 (Sophomore Status)	1.8
60+ (Junior/Senior Status)	2.0

Notes:

- "Hours attempted" includes everything: transfer hours, repeated courses, courses taken pass/fail, etc.
- Any student enrolled in their first or second semester at Greensboro College must earn at least a 1.0 grade point average (GPA) in order to enroll in the following semester or the student will be academically withdrawn from the College.
- Any student who falls below the 1.6, 1.8, or 2.0 requirements will be placed on academic probation for the next semester. He/she must raise their cumulative GPA to the required minimum by the end of that probationary semester. Failure to do so results in academic suspension.
- Any student who is academically withdrawn or suspended has the right to appeal. Appeal procedures are outlined in the Academic Catalog, available electronically at www.greensboro.edu/academics/course-catalog/
